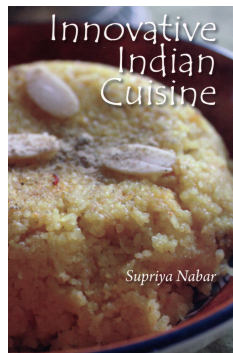

Local author Supriya Nabar will be here to discuss her book *Innovative Indian Cuisine*. Samples will be provided and books will be available for purchase.

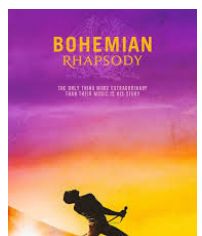
